

**Items students/parents must bring to Super Saturday**

You will need records of income earned in the year prior to when you will start school as well as a few other documents in order to complete the FAFSA. You may also need records of your parents' income, if you are a dependent student. To organize your information, print this page and check off the items as you collect them to ensure you bring them with you to Super Saturday.

<input type="checkbox"/>	Your U.S. Department of Education issued <b>Personal Identification Number</b> (PIN). The student and one parent must have separate PINs. Register for PIN at <a href="http://www.pin.ed.gov">www.pin.ed.gov</a>
<input type="checkbox"/>	Your and your parents/spouses <b>Social Security numbers</b>
<input type="checkbox"/>	Your <b>Driver's License</b> (if available)
<input type="checkbox"/>	Your and your parents/spouses <b>2009 W-2 forms</b> and records of other monies earned
<input type="checkbox"/>	Your and your parents/spouses <b>2009 Federal Income Tax Return</b> , i.e. 1040, 1040A, 1040EZ, Foreign Tax return, etc
<input type="checkbox"/>	Your family's <b>untaxed income records</b> – Social Security, Temporary Assistance to Needy Families (TANF), child support received, worker's compensations, welfare or veterans benefits records
<input type="checkbox"/>	Your and your parents/spouses <b>current bank statements</b>
<input type="checkbox"/>	Your and your parents/spouses <b>current investment records</b> , such as business and investment mortgage information, business and farm records, stocks, bonds, and other investment records
<input type="checkbox"/>	Your <b>alien registration</b> or <b>permanent resident card</b> (if you are not a U.S. citizen)
