Who are we?

The Arlington Youth Philanthropy Initiative (AYPI) was created by the Arlington Community Foundation. AYPI's Youth Board members review and approve grant funding for youth-led projects and monitoring their launch and progress.

What are project requirements?

Projects should be sustainable and impact Arlington or involve Arlington students.

How to apply:

AYPI's application process to receive grant funding is a three-part process:

- 1) the submission of a **Preliminary Application** to determine eligibility
- 2) the preparation of an **Action Plan**, to provide more details of the project
- 3) a **Presentation** to AYPI's Youth Board, which decides on grant funding.
