In response to these trying economic times, then County Board Chair Barbara Favola and John Shooshan, founder of The Shooshan Company, teamed up to strengthen the safety net protecting the most vulnerable members of the community. By helping to establish the **Emergency Needs — Homelessness Prevention Fund at the Arlington Community Foundation**, they have provided a new way to help Arlingtonians who have been hit hard by the economic crisis and are homeless or at risk of becoming homeless.

As part of this Emergency Needs Fund, the Arlington Community Foundation will offer **Prompt Response to Emergency Needs Grants** up to \$3,000 for 501 (c) 3 organizations that provide **temporary, emergency assistance** such as rent, food and services to individuals and families in Arlington County and have come upon unexpected, urgent community needs or unanticipated opportunities. Applicants whose proposals are approved for funding can expect to receive funds within a few weeks. Applications will be accepted on a rolling basis and based on the availability of funds.

To apply, submit **one** original application in one or two pages. Applications may be mailed, hand-delivered, faxed or e-mailed. Please include:

- Description of organization
- Emergency or unexpected community needs that will be addressed
- Proposal of goals and activities along with timetable for proposed grant
- Itemized budget

The Foundation requires that grant recipients submit a one-page Final Report within thirty (30) days after the completion of the project for which the funds are intended.
